Here's what you'll learn each week:



Week 1: Foundations of Technology

Engage in a project to apply these skills, and join a coaching call on civic responsibility, focusing on civic rights, environmental stewardship, and promoting social justice.

This week is dedicated to mastering social media management. Understand different platforms, practical applications, and content creation techniques. Learn about two-factor authentication and basic design using Canva. The coaching call will provide insights into monetizing your personal brand through sponsored posts, affiliate marketing, digital products, and freelancing. You'll also learn why it might be important to create a personal website and the importance of continuous learning and adaptation.



Week 6: Final Assessments and Reflection

Conclude the course with final assessments to review and demonstrate your newfound skills and knowledge. Reflect on your journey, celebrate milestones, and plan for future growth with guidance from our final coaching call.

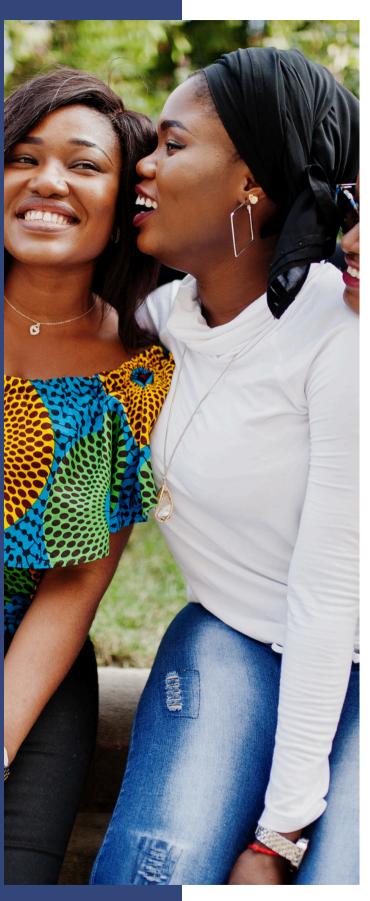


Why Enroll in The Digital Launchpad?
